

2015 Confucius Institute Scholarship

The Confucius Institute scholarship was established with funding support from the Confucius Institute Headquarters/Hanban. The scholarship is awarded through the Confucius Institute in Atlanta at Emory University (www.confucius.emory.edu). These awards, at \$500 each, provide financial assistance towards study abroad related expenses for participants in Emory Summer China Studies Program. Recipients of the Confucius Institute Scholarship are selected based on the quality of application materials submitted and will receive a living expense stipend during the first four weeks at Nanjing University. The study must be completed within calendar year of 2015.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 2.5 GPA or higher
- Current enrollment at Emory
- Non-native speaker of Chinese
- Non-Chinese citizen

Application Process:

Deadline: February 15, 2015

Submit your applications in hard copy by 5 pm on the posted deadline to Laura Hunt in the REALC office (202 Modern Languages building). Only completed applications will be considered.

- Complete CI Scholarship cover sheet
- Application essay of no less than 800 words
- Unofficial Emory transcript

Awarding Process:

The Confucius Institute Scholarship will be released directly to the student as a living expense stipend during the study at Nanjing University.

Notification of Award Status:

Students selected for the scholarship will be notified of their status by email.

*It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the scholarship application is complete and accurate.

Requirements to complete upon return:

- A photo essay/report on your study abroad experience. Please note that all materials submitted for this mandatory essay/report become the property of Emory and the Confucius Institute and may be used in print and/or electronic publications. Please send reports to: Department of Russian and East Asian Languages and Cultures and the Confucius Institute in Atlanta at Emory.
- Participation at study abroad fairs
- Class visits and presentations to promote study abroad among Emory community
